

REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDER A FLAG STATE INSPECTOR

1. A Certificate issued under the relevant provisions of the STCW Convention, as amended, as:
 - 1-1 Master, enabling that person to command a ship of 3,000 GT or more; or
 - 1-2 Chief engineer, enabling the person to command the machinery installed in a ship powered by main propulsion machinery of 3,000 KW or more; or
 - 1-3 Meet the provisions of the Radio Regulations or hold an appropriate certificate related to GMDSS;
2. A university degree or diploma as a naval architect, mechanical engineer, electro technical engineer, engineer whose professional education relates to the maritime industry; and
 - 2.1 Not less than five years service as an officer on board a ship at sea, or in a capacity as naval architect, or as an engineer in the maritime field.
3. A relevant university degree or diploma, must be augmented by completion of the IMO model courses: 3.03 Machinery, 3.04 Electrical Installations, 3.05 Fire Appliances and Provisions, 3.06 Life-Saving Appliances, 3.07 Hull, and 3.08 Navigation and has relevant sea- service of not less than six months, or a document to prove any experience or update knowledge in relation of the Maritime Industry or any Maritime Organization.
4. Application form must be duly fulfilled.
5. Medical examination must be submitted.
6. Copy of passport.
7. In case of renewal, last ten vessels inspected.

Note: Documents must be authenticated by Panamanian consulate or notary public, in case documents are in different language than English or Spanish, also must be duly translated.
